DRESS RULES

All members and visitors are asked to dress in an appropriate manner, as may be specified from time to time by the Council and displayed on the Club's notice boards.

Members are particularly asked to ensure that their guests are made aware of the standards of dress required at Ham Manor Golf Club.

Societies and Visitors will be advised of the Dress Code before they play or enter the Club.

The Management reserve the right to request anyone who is considered to be inappropriately dressed to change their attire.

The Clubhouse

- Blue denim jeans, singlets, non-tailored shorts (ie sports and beach shorts) are not acceptable forms of dress.
- Training shoes are not permitted except juniors under the age of 12 years.
- No golf shoes of any kind are permitted in the main bar area, snooker room lounge or dining room at any time but golf shoes are permitted in the 'Spike Bar'.
- Smart casual dress, including tailored shorts, is acceptable in the Clubhouse, but Members and Visitors are asked to refrain from wearing wet or muddy clothes which have been worn on the course.
- Hats must not be worn indoors.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times except for Ladies blouson style shirts.
- Casual shoes, ie loafers etc, may be worn without socks. Beach style "flip flops"/ sandals are not permitted. Sandals may be worn with socks.
- Smart casual dress is also acceptable in the Restaurant Monday – Saturday.
For Sunday Lunch, Men, as a minimum, are required to wear, collared shirts, with a tie Or jacket.
- Mobile phones may not be used in the Clubhouse.

The Golf Course

- Golfers using the course are expected to wear attire sold for golf, including studded golfing footwear.
- Hats/Caps are to be worn with peak forward.
- Blue denim clothing, cargo pants, combat trousers trainers, non-tailored shorts, trousers tucked into socks (except plus 2s & plus 4s) and shell/tracksuits are not permitted.
- Predominately white short socks and ultra low socks may be worn with tailored shorts.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times except for Ladies blouson style shirts.
